

Accelerated Reader

All Kindergarten through 4th grade students at Tarver-Rendon are expected to participate in the Accelerated Reader (AR) program. Students have a point goal and a certification level set for them by their homeroom teacher each six weeks. Students are encouraged to read books on their reading level that will also count towards their certification requirements. After completing the books, students login to AR and take tests. Students earn points based on the number of questions answered correctly. When a student scores 80% or higher on the test for a book that meets their certification criteria, that book counts towards their certification. **Remember, point goal and certification are independent of each other. It is possible for students to reach only the point goal OR only a new certification each six weeks.**

When students reach a new certification they have the privilege of marching in the AR parade for that six weeks. Students who meet their point goal for the six weeks will participate in a grade level celebration.
